Box 264, Linnton, Oregon, birthplace Amritsar, India, and age 26 years and 9 months; and was honorably discharged December 16, 1918, at Camp Lewis, Washington, a private, 2nd Company, Development Battalion #1, 166th Depot Brigade, character recorded as excellent. At the time of his registration for the draft he stated that he was a "declarant".
