Revered and beloved Bhai ji

Are you surprised to hear from me from this strange address. I came to Omaha, after spending the loveliest two weeks of my life with my loved ones, and on my third day of lectures yesterday they arrested me and railroaded the next for 90 days in this County Jail, because I did not register under their City law as a "missionary", healer and a medium etc. I told them I don't practice any of these at any time, but it is plain tyranny born of racial, national and religious bigotry. Bhai ji almost all of my money was spent in buying and furnishing our home, and it is not fully paid for. I have never yet asked anyone for help, but circumstances are compelling me to ask of you two to three hundred dollars or as much as you are capable of helping. Please remit the same to Mrs B. S. Thind 1466 Queens Road (Hollywood) Los Angeles, Cal. as early as possible for there are no funds available at present for their upkeep and for the payment on the house etc.

I am sorry to turn out to be a "beggar", but I shall make every cent good in time. I shall be out on Oct 2.
